This school year the Sharing the Road with Trucks program completed 74 high school visits, reaching nearly 9,500 driver education students across three states (Virginia, Delaware, and West Virginia). While this program targets teen drivers, Sharing the Road with Trucks can benefit drivers of all ages. With that in mind, the team conducted two Sharing the Road with Trucks train-the-trainer sessions and engaged 115 driver instructors from the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP). These instructors are located across the United States and are now able to provide older drivers with the five key strategies to safely navigate around tractor-trailers and other commercial motor vehicles on our roadways. Additionally, the team participated in seven community events, including the Delaware Special Olympics Truck Convoy. A total of 221 trucks participated in this 35-mile convoy through Kent County, Delaware, with VTTI's Sharing the Road with Trucks program winning the award for best truck. Further, the team presented at the Virginia Trucking Association's annual safety conference held in Williamsburg, Virginia.

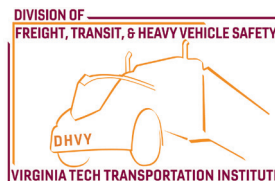


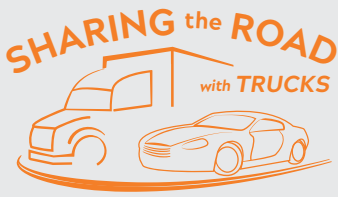
